

Donor Guidelines

To ensure a safe and enjoyable donation for yourself and others at Prometic Plasma Resources, we would like to share the following:

- Prometic Plasma Resources is a medical facility. All staff, equipment, property and fellow donors should be treated with respect.
- Donors are expected to arrive on time for their appoints. If unable to make scheduled appointment time, please contact Prometic Plasma Resources in advance to reschedule.
 - Continual appointment tardiness may result in deferral from future donations.
 - Continual “No Shows” to scheduled appointments may result in deferral from future donations.
 - Donors should be prepared to remain at Prometic Plasma Resources for the entirety of their appointment. If you feel you will need to leave mid-way though an appointment, please reschedule for another time.
- To help ensure donor safety, we ask that donors refrain from the following during a donation: speaking on a cell phone, wearing sunglasses, eating, drinking or sleeping. Headphones or “silent mode” are suggested for any electronic device that can make noise.
- Proper attire, hygiene and attitude are expected of all donors at all times.
 - Shirts and shoes are required.
 - Smoking is not permitted inside the facility or outside of the main entrance.
 - Foul or inappropriate language is not allowed at any time.
- If a donor must bring their child to an appointment, please make sure there is a supervising adult present at all times. Donors are considered unable to supervise children during a donation.
- Prometic Plasma Resources encourages everyone to become a donor, but as blood and/or plasma donation is a privilege we therefore have the right to exclude donors from future donations for any disregard to the Donor Guidelines.
